With more than 20 years journalism experience behind her, Ali Moore is the host of the ABC's nightly television business current affairs program, Lateline Business. She is also a regular host of the flagship current affairs program, The 7.30 Report, and for the latter half of last year hosted the ABC's morning radio program in Melbourne.

Ali began her career at the ABC after completing a Bachelor of Arts at Melbourne University. In 1992 she was appointed China Correspondent, based in Beijing. When she returned to Sydney three years later, Ali became the ABC's national Finance Correspondent.

In 1996 Ali moved to the Nine Network to work on the weekly business current affairs program, Business Sunday, first as a reporter, and then as host of the program.

Over the past decade she has interviewed the key decision makers in Australian business, including the CEOs of the country's top listed companies. Her interviews and stories have covered the major political, economic and corporate issues in both Australia and around the world, reporting locally and from both Asia and Europe.
